



## **Understanding Your Blood Pressure Monitor**

Top Number = Systolic blood pressure (Sys)

Bottom Number = Diastolic blood pressure

Pul (can be in different \_ Pulse or how fast places depending on your monitor)

your heart is beating

## **Top Number = Systolic Blood Pressure**

- Measures your blood pressure when your heart beats
- This is when your heart is pushing blood into your body

## **Bottom Number = Diastolic Blood Pressure**

- Measures your blood pressure when your heart rests
- This is when your heart is filling with blood

## Pul = Pulse or Heart Rate

- Measures how fast your heart is beating
- Your heart is sometimes slower or faster
- Some machines will show the fastest (max or maximum)
